Spectating Information

Our annual Sports Day is due to take place on Wednesday 15th May. P1 (Nursery and Reception) and P2 (years 1, 2 & 3) sports day will commence at 9.30am and the P3 (years 4, 5 & 6) event at 1.00pm.

Could we ask that all family members who are attending the P1 and P2 event please use the P3 gate at the top of the school drive (Years 4, 5 & 6 entrance). Gates will be open from 9:15am. P3 family members will enter through the P3 gate from 12:50pm.

To ensure the security of all of our pupils, please be aware of the following

All gates will be locked, should you need to leave the premises there will be a member of staff to unlock the P3 gate. Please note that we are a non-smoking site (this includes the car park) and there will be no access through the school building. Furthermore, we ask parents to stay within the taped area and not come across the track, field or yard to see their child during or after the event.

We will not allow children to leave directly from the school field; instead, children will be taken back to class and dismissed by their teacher via the normal exits.

If you wish to take photographs or videos of your child during sports day, then you are welcome to, but, as always, we ask that these are not shared on any social media platforms this is to respect privacy and protection of children.

The PTFA will be selling refreshments for spectators during the morning and afternoon.

Parking

We encourage parents to walk to our Sports Day, if you are unable to and need to come by car, our School Police Liaison Officer has been made aware of the event. She will be patrolling the area to ensure that cars are parked in a way that respects our local residents and ensures access for the service bus to navigate through the area.

Uniform

We have ordered some fine weather for the day, so could you please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their **house coloured t-shirt**, black shorts/ jogging bottoms, trainers, a hat, and has adequate sun-tan lotion applied before coming to school (please note that staff are not permitted to apply the sun cream onto children). Children will all take their own water/drinks bottle onto the field. Children are also asked to wear P.E. kit for the whole week. As part of our 'OLYMPICS' topic, We have arranged for Ady Jones Tae Kwon Do, The Tennis Centre, 'Paige Coates Street Vibes' and Wrexham Rugby Club to deliver tester sessions to our children during the week.
